Restriction and declaration of contents in products, components, materials and preparations

1. Scope of application

This regulation applies to all products, components, materials and substances (mixtures) processed in our products. It is supplemental to our general terms and conditions for all delivered goods. The declarations and substance restrictions in the regulations/laws listed in section 2 are always to be adhered to and communicated to us. References to manufacturer-specific websites will not suffice in this respect. We expect the unprompted provision of all current safety datasheets in German, insofar as these have to be compiled for the substances and/or preparations.

2. Restriction and declaration

2.1. EU-RoHs – **Directive 2011/65/EU** of the European Parliament and of the Council of June 8, 2011 on the Restrictions of Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment:

- Substance restrictions for: lead (0.1%); mercury (0.1%); cadmium (0.01%); hexavalent chromium (0.1%); polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1%); polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %); diethylhexyl phthalate (DEHP) (0.1%); butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1%); dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%); diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%).
- In the case of recourse to exception regulations, information about the exception regulation and the quantity of the substance used are to be provided.

2.2. REACH – **Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006** of the European Parliament and of the Council of December 18, 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/67/EEC, 93/105/EC and 2000/21/EC:

- Restricted substances in accordance with REACH Annex XIV
- In the case of restriction of use of substances listed in REACH Annex XIV or in the Candidate List (<https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table>), information regarding the restriction and the quantity of the substance used must be provided.

2.3. **Global Automotive Declarable Substance List – GADSL** (www.gadsl.org)

Declarations and restrictions in accordance with the current GADSL Reference List are to be adhered to.

2.4. **VerpackG** – Regulation concerning the market introduction, the return and the high-quality utilization of packaging

- Substance restrictions in accordance with § 5 (the accumulative concentration of lead, cadmium, mercury and chromium VI must not exceed 100 milligrams per kilogram)
- Annex 3 and Annex 4: Permissible heavy-metal content
